

## RRSP Income Tax Receipts

**Friday March 1, 2019** is the deadline for contributing to an RRSP for the 2018 tax year. Assumption Life's Investments and Retirement team issues income tax receipts in January and March of each year for the year just ended. **We anticipate beginning to mail out RRSP Income Tax Receipts on the dates indicated below:**

<b>Contribution Periods for Pre-Authorized Debits (PAD)</b>	<b>Mail Out Date</b>
Contributions made during the period of March 1 to December 31 2018	January 18 2019
Contributions made during the period of January 1 to March 1 2019	March 15 2019

Income tax receipts for **Adhoc Deposits** will be mailed on a weekly basis depending on the volume processed.

## Annual Tax Information Slips for 2018

In January and February of each year, Assumption Life's tax team issues tax information slips for the year just ended. The deadline for issuing tax information slips in Canada is February 28 for all slips with the exception of T3s, for which the deadline for issuing is March 31.

**We anticipate beginning to mail out tax information slips during the week of February 18, 2019.**

## CANADIAN TAX INFORMATION SLIPS

<b><u>Information Slip</u></b>	<b><u>Income Type</u></b>
T4A	Scholarships and bursaries, group insurance disability benefits, supplementary contracts, immediate annuities, pension fund benefits, pension fund withdrawals
T4RSP	Partial or total withdrawals or annuities from RRSPs
T4RIF	Partial or total withdrawals or disbursements from RRIFs
T5	Interest earned on : policies on deposit, dividends/premiums on deposit, claims, non-registered deferred contracts (GIAs), mortgage tax reserves and policy gains
T3	Allocation of income from segregated funds (interest, foreign income, dividends and capital gains or losses on segregated funds) and capital gains or losses from client withdrawals from segregated funds
NR4	Any amounts credited to a non-resident of Canada
T5007	Workers' compensation benefit (WHSCC)
